Changes in the composition of the Supervisory Board and Audit Committee

On June 29, 2022, the General Meeting of ČEZ, a. s., which opened on June 28, 2022, decided on the following changes in the composition of the Supervisory Board of ČEZ, a. s:

Roman Binder and the new Vice-Chairman Bc. Milan Wagner, who was elected to the Supervisory Board by the company's employees.
